Dear Parents and Carers,

Schools are working closely alongside Public Health England and COVID preventative measures are in place across the country. This means schools are doing all they can to reduce the spread but great care is still essential from everyone in the school community to make sure this remains the case.

Warwickshire County Council have now asked all parents and carers to **wear a face mask during morning drop off and afternoon pick up**. From this point on, we would be most grateful if you followed this simple bit of advice and supported our school community in doing its best to stay safe. Our staff may choose to do so too in some cases.

With cases rising, we must continue to do all we can to reduce the spread. In addition to wearing face masks, it is important to:

- Follow the government's guidance about social distancing - keeping 2m apart – especially when dropping off and picking up children from school and nursery. There are still reports of non-distanced gatherings amongst parents at some schools and we must ask again that this does not happen. It causes difficulties for staff at school in keeping the environment COVID safe for everyone.
- Wash hands regularly.
- Self-isolate immediately for 10 days if you or your child or children have symptoms, or 14 days if you have been in contact with someone who has tested Covid-19 positive.
- If your child is sent home to self-isolate then they **MUST** do just that. This period of isolation means **ALL** day and does not mean just staying away from school and nursery; it means staying at home.
- If you have COVID symptoms of a high temperature, new continuous cough or loss or change to your sense of taste or smell you can book a test online.
