



## **Remote Learning January 2021**

Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

We were pleased to welcome some of you back to school today and look forward to welcoming some more of you over the next few days. School has been a little bit strange to begin with but our expectations for learning and behaviour remain as high as ever.

Please take note of the points below and know that we wish you all, at home and at school, the very best.

Keep safe and well.

### **For children of key workers or vulnerable groups coming in to school from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021, the following measures/precautions **must** be taken:**

#### **Administration:**

- Thorough hand washing to take place at home just before leaving the home. Hands to be washed when entering the building.
- Children should enter the school through the car park gate, including Reception children, at their usual time of 8:45am to 8:55am.
- We assume your contact details for family members are up to date and **someone must be available** on the emergency contact details should your child become poorly/exhibit symptoms of contracting coronavirus.
- The office will be open as usual and emails will be checked regularly during the day: [admin3068@welearn365.com](mailto:admin3068@welearn365.com)
- **Please do not contact teachers directly via email or on Teams; they are teaching.**

#### **Health:**

- Your child **MUST** be fit and well to attend school. Do not send them if they are poorly in any way. If a child becomes poorly during the day we will contact you and you must collect them immediately from the site.
- If you become unwell with coronavirus symptoms, you must **immediately** contact school and arrange for collection of your child.
- Social distancing **must** be enforced whilst your child is **not** in school if we are to prevent/minimise the spread of infection.
- School **must** be informed if you no longer fall within the critical worker list or you have been asked to self-isolate.
- Children must be dropped off by **8:55 am and picked up at 3:15pm promptly.**
- **KS2 children will be ready to be collected at 3:15pm the same as KS1 children.**

**Food:**

- Children in school may bring their own packed lunch or have a school lunch as normal.
- Children bringing their own lunch need to bring it in a disposable bag/packaging not a lunchbox and this will be disposed of in school.
- Those children who pay for lunch need to make payments in the usual way with Baileys.
- Children MUST have their own refillable water bottle named in school which they will bring home each day to be thoroughly cleaned. Please return them empty each day and they will be filled at school.

**Clothing and bags:**

- School uniform is required each day as normal. School is open as normal for you.
- School PE kit is required on the children's usual PE days.
- Do **not** bring any bags or books or materials into school- all materials will be provided.

**For children undertaking remote learning:**

- Your school work will be uploaded to Teams ready for each day.
- You will have Maths, English and another piece of work each day.
- Reception children will have a variety of activities to try at home.

- Your teacher will invite you to take part in live feedback or teaching sessions where necessary.
- Your teacher is running face-to-face teaching as well as remote learning and they are not always able to reply immediately.
