

Returning to school - how will it work?



Before you leave your house

- ★ Wear a fresh set of uniform every day.
- ★ On your PE days you can wear your PE kit into school and home again.
- ★ Make sure you only have your water bottle, sun hat/coat and packed lunch with you.
- ★ You will need a book bag for your reading books and Reading Record; this needs to be a book bag not a rucksack please.
- ★ Wash your hands before you leave home.
- ★ You must to keep a distance from the other parents and children coming into school.

Returning to school - how will it work?



Arriving at school

- ★ You will need to arrive between 8:45am and 8:55am.
- ★ If you are little early you **must** stand away from other people. This is very important.
- ★ You must enter from School Lane and an adult will be there to direct you to your line.
- ★ An adult will walk you to the classroom altogether.

Returning to school - how will it work?



Entering your classroom

- ★ As you enter school, you will hang your bags and coats on your pegs and wash your hands.
- ★ You will have a chair and space just for you.
- ★ You might be reminded about keeping a distance from the adults in school.
- ★ It is really important to us that you feel happy and safe at school.
- ★ If you are upset by anything, tell one of the adults in your room and we will help you.
- ★ You must do exactly as the adults ask you to, this is to keep everyone safe.

Returning to school - how will it work?



Inside the classroom

- ★ You will have lots of equipment waiting for you to use that is just for you.
- ★ Lots of learning will also take place outside.
- ★ If you need the toilet, you can go, but you must ask first and not spend time with other children.
- ★ You must also be sure to wash your hands after.
- ★ If you need to cough or sneeze then you must 'catch it, bin it, kill it'.

Returning to school - how will it work?



Catch it, bin it, kill it

- ★ 'Catch it' means you sneeze in a tissue or your elbow.
- ★ 'Bin it' means you put your tissue in the bin as soon as possible.
- ★ 'Kill it' means you wash your hands.
- ★ There will be tissues and a pedal bin in your classroom so you can safely throw away your tissues.

Returning to school - how will it work?



Break

- ★ You will still have your break times outside with your friends.
- ★ You can only play with children in your key stage and you will have lots of play equipment to use.
- ★ When you come in from break, you must wash your hands.

Returning to school - how will it work?



Lunchtime

- ★ You will eat your lunch in the classroom with an adult.
- ★ If you are having a school lunch it will be brought to you.
- ★ Once you have finished lunch, your adult will take you outside to play.
- ★ If it is a wet playtime we will play in the classroom or take it in turns to play in the hall.
- ★ If you fall over at lunchtime or break time and you need first aid, an adult will help you but they might be wearing some different clothes such as a mask, gloves and an apron.
- ★ When you come in from lunch, you must wash your hands.

Returning to school - how will it work?



If you feel unwell

- ★ If you have a high temperature (37.8) or a new cough, we will contact your parents.
- ★ Someone will take you to a separate room in school to make sure you are okay and your parents will be called to collect you.
- ★ The adult looking after you will be wearing different clothes such as a mask, an apron and gloves that help them to keep germs away.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- ★ If you feel unwell or adults have to help you with first aid, they will wear some strange clothes so that we can all stay safe.
- ★ Adults will wear a mask, gloves, an apron or even a face shield.
- ★ Behind the PPE is one of the adults in school and it is completely normal. You might have seen lots of people wearing gloves or masks in the supermarket or on the television already.

Returning to school - how will it work?



Leaving school at the end of the day

- ★ Your parents will collect you between 3:20pm and 3:30pm from the gate at the front of school.
- ★ Before you leave you must wash your hands.
- ★ Your adult will call you to the gate to meet your parent.
- ★ When you leave with your parent you must try not to mix with other children.

When you get home

- ★ Wash your hands as soon as you get home.
- ★ Tell your parents or carers about your fantastic day of learning!
