Willow Class have been reading *The Thing* in their live lessons this week. For art, they designed their own Things. Here are some examples from children at home and school.



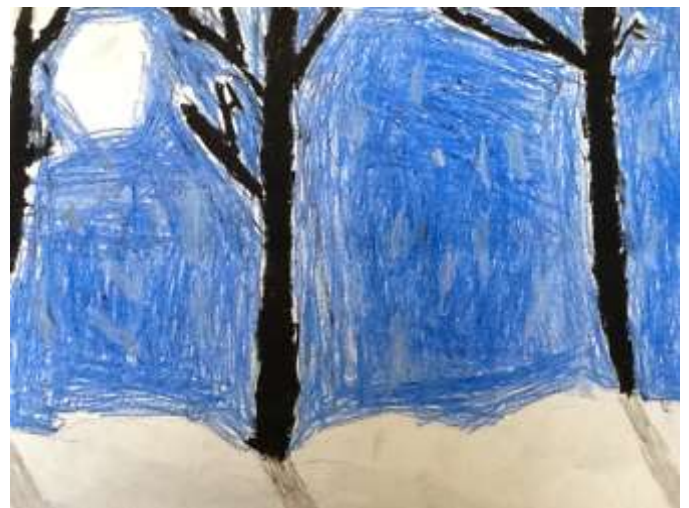
### Silver Birch Class
