Dear Parents and Carers,

Not quite the welcome back we expected but a warm welcome back to school nonetheless. Nothing about 2020 has been quite as we expected but I am continually amazed at how well our children are coping with constant changes. ### Government Guidelines

Please be aware of the government guidelines covering the four-week period of 5th November to 2nd December.

You are advised to keep your children at home if they are unwell. If they develop a new or continuous cough, a temperature or they lose their sense of taste or smell, then you should book a coronavirus test for your child as soon as possible. If anyone in your household develops symptoms, the household must isolate until a test result has been returned.

There should be no mixing of households, inside or outside, unless a support bubble is formed or an extended family member such as a grandparent provides childcare. This will mean parents will need to ensure they have adequate childcare arrangements in place.

Face coverings are requested at drop off and collection times and we ask all parents to observe adequate social distancing while on the school site.

We ask all our families to carefully observe these guidelines to keep our entire school community safe. We also ask you to inform the school via email to [admin3068@welearn365.com](mailto:admin3068@welearn365.com) as soon as possible should your family need to isolate or be tested.
